





The economy of Schaffhausen is characterised by an exciting mix of international business service providers and innovative businesses with highly-developed tech capabilities.

Traditional manufacturing companies heralded a new era here 150 years ago. Today's businesses work on software sensors and IoT applications, develop global marketing strategies and optimise value-chains across continents. Schaffhausen's economy has undergone a huge transformation. In the last century, the landscape was defined by the chimneys of iron smelting furnaces and aluminium works. Today, the economy is shaped by the innovations emanating from the life science and medtech sectors, by the development of autonomous vehicles and by the packaging sector, whose

competences in synthetics and precision engineering characterise the modern-day manufacturing base in the region and which is highly successful in export markets around the world.

In the last 20 years, Schaffhausen has become a preferred location for multinationals. The Canton's government has consistently pursued a targeted strategy which has attracted around 600 businesses to set up operations in Schaffhausen. Many companies have established their international HQ and central business units in the region. These now form part of the local business landscape alongside highly innovative businesses specialising in advanced manufacturing and R&D.





19th century *Industrial pioneers*

Several major businesses were established in Schaffhausen: the Georg Fischer (GF) foundry, rolling stock company SIG, aluminium manufacturer Aluminium Industrie AG (now Alusuisse) and the International Watch Company Schaffhausen (IWC).

Mid-19th century 1863 energy production

The Moser Dam across the River Rhine harnessed water-power, thereby securing reliable energy production, which continues to the present day, and provided the foundations for further industrialisation.

Mid-20th century *Manufacturing*

Schaffhausen is a significant industrial and manufacturing centre in Switzerland. The competences in process technology and advanced engineering developed since that time are the foundations for the high-tech manufacturing operations here today and the innovations of tomorrow.

Today *Technologies of the future*

Schaffhausen has a diverse business community, including industrial companies with a local or international focus and service providers with global markets. The technologies of the future are being created at the interface of these sectors, where digital applications and industrial solutions merge.

Schaffhausen encompasses around 2 million employees within an hour's travel-time. The canton's catchment area includes leading universities such as the world-renowned Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH), the University of St.Gallen and a number of specialist university-level institutes. Collaborations between specialist local businesses and the public sector are driving the creation of new competence centres in growth areas such as the Internet of Things (IoT), e-mobility and materials and process technologies.

The development of skills and business networks in Schaffhausen is supported by public funding: regional platforms such as the Schaffhausen Industry & Technology Knowledge Hub (ITS), Swiss Materials and INNO-PACK.NET connect local businesses, accelerate knowledge transfer between companies and develop the capability to innovate within the region's businesses.



Attractive corporate tax rates, state-of-the-art business premises at affordable prices and low costs of living - companies in Schaffhausen profit from a range of cost benefits. As a result, they have more available to invest in their business.

Moderate corporate taxation

Several multinational businesses manage their regional or global operations from a base in Schaffhausen, with a wide range of HQ models and operations in place. A key factor in the decision to move to Schaffhausen is frequently the internationally and nationally very attractive corporate tax regime, backed by the Canton of Schaffhausen's consistent strategy to develop the area as a business location. With a total corporate tax liability of just 12-12,5 percent, Schaffhausen ranks among the top business locations globally. The introduction of a patent box regime as well as superdeductions on R&D costs are further measures by which the canton is underpinning its strengths as a business environment which promotes and nurtures innovation. Businesses with focus on innovation can benefit from cantonal support and tax concessions.

A great proposition with significant cost benefits

You will find modern offices on the banks of the River Rhine or right next to the railway station, industrial sites with excellent road and rail links as well as an old town quarter full of charm and which is home to many commercial premises - Schaffhausen offers you an extensive portfolio of different types of premises at affordable rates. Compared to other cantons, salary levels for many occupational groups are lower, too. As a result, businesses enjoy significant cost benefits.
